### **Traffic Update: Camino de Oeste and Moore Road As of 2/24/2021**

Paving is completed on Camino de Oeste and Moore Road and the roadway is now open to traffic. Landscaping work will be ongoing through the end of May, so please observe any traffic control signage and watch for workers and equipment.

For your safety and that of the contractor's personnel, please comply with traffic control devices, flagging personnel, and/or detour signs.

Travel time through the project area may increase during construction so please adjust your schedule accordingly. Construction may restrict traffic lanes and create congestion.

Taking alternate routes is suggested.

If inclement weather or other events cause delays, the work may be rescheduled without further notice.

The Marana Board of Adjustment is a 7-

member quasi-judicial body of citizens whose main functions are (1) to hear and decide citizen appeals from the Zoning Administrator's interpretations of the Marana zoning regulations; and (2) to consider citizen requests for variances from Marana zoning regulations.

Applicants must be Marana residents.

Scheduled meetings are at 2:00 p.m. on the second Tuesday of each month in the Council Chambers, or as needed. **The deadline to submit an application is March 8, 2021 by 4 p.m.** or until all positions are filled. All applications will remain active for one year from the date of receipt.
